

Decorative band with fir trees

Difficulty Level



Materials

THREAD QUANTITY/COLOUR

Anchor Stranded Cotton

worked with 3 strands, 1 skein each of #2, #20, #62, #72 and #1050 and 1 spool Anchor Metallic, colour 301

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

approx. 50 cm (20 inches) Anchor linen band, 16 cm (6 ¼ inches) wide, in natural; 1 felt sheets in Ruby and 1 sheet in Baby Pink

EMBROIDERY TECHNIQUES

chain stitch, straight stitch, and cross stitch (over 2 x 2 fabric threads)

NOTIONS

Embroidery needle with sharp point and Tapestry needle with blunt point; decorative hanger ca. 20 cm; 3 small wooden clips; glue; small beads; matching Coats sewing thread

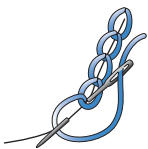

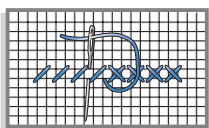


Instructions

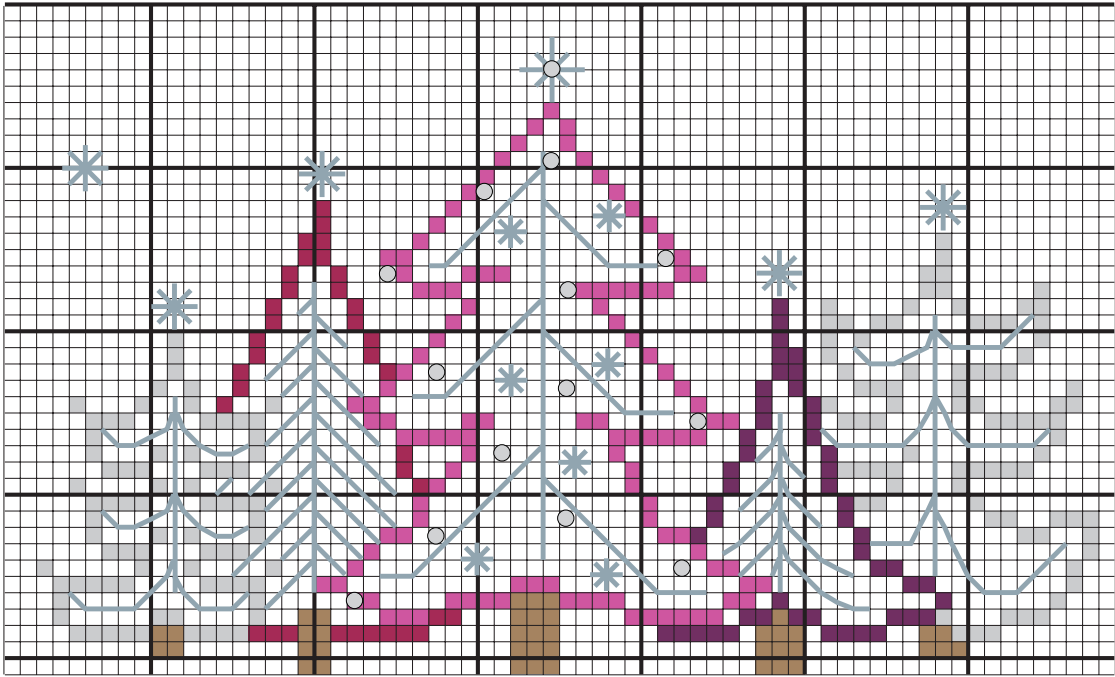
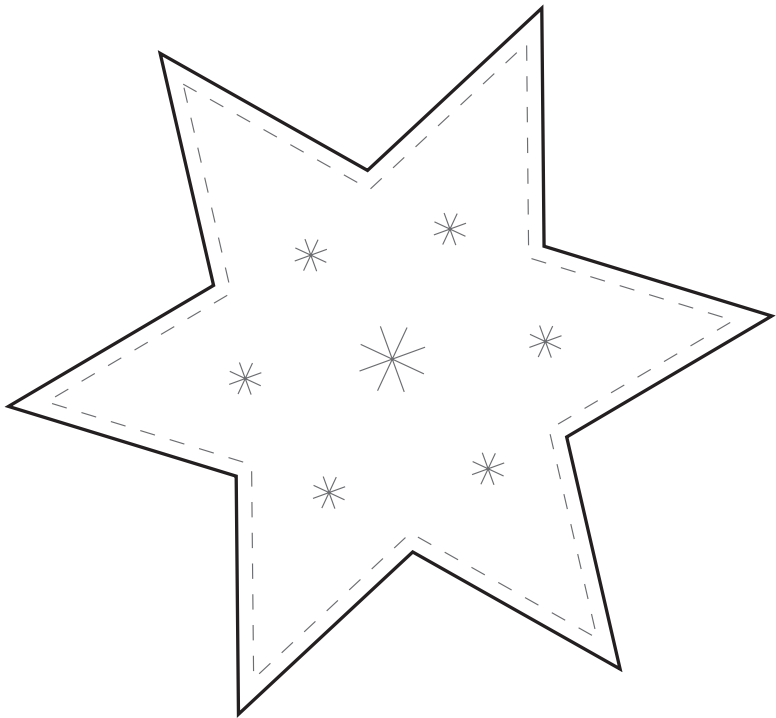
All you need to do: Neaten both cut ends of the linen band with zigzag stitching. Begin embroidering the fir trees approx. 28 cm (11 inches) from the lower edge. To form the pocket, fold the lower 12.5 cm (5 inches) up, fold the raw edge under, 1 cm (¾ inch) wide, and edgestitch in place. Edgestitch the side edges closed. To form a tunnel for the decorative hanger, fold the upper edge to the wrong side, 2 cm (¾ inch) wide. Machine stitch 1.5 cm from the fold, leaving ends open so that the hanger can be inserted. Use straight stitch to embroider small stars, then decorate some with beads, as desired. Trace star shapes onto felt and cut out. Embroider stars as shown in photo. Glue wooden clip to back of each felt star to attach it to the band.
